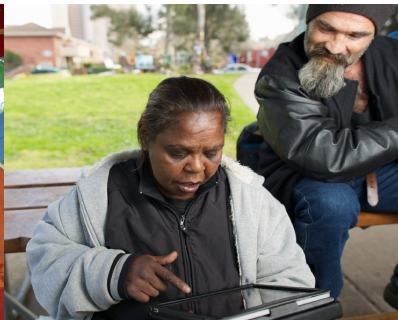
INDIGENOUS FORCES AT WORK CONFERENCE 2012
